Following the blessing of the boats, there was a blessing of the clubhouse and DBC members. No members of the club passed away in 2019 so we honored our family and friends.


Day Cruise/anchorout in Mandalay Channel Saturday March 21

LATE RENEWAL OF MEMBERSHIP IS STILL POSSIBLE.


If you have not paid for your 2020 membership yet, you can still mail a check to:

Book Club...


April 8th, 2020 meeting Cathy Goocher is our host




